COVID-19 ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY
FOR IN-PERSON ACTIVITIES

COVID-19 is highly contagious, is known to spread mainly from person-to-person contact, and may result in significant personal injury or death. You acknowledge that you are fully aware that participation in any in-person NAWBO San Antonio activities carries with it certain inherent risks related to COVID-19 transmission that cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid such risks.

By attending NAWBO San Antonio activities in person, you acknowledge the inherent risk of you, and by extension your household, becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19. You assume the foregoing risks and waive any liability against the National Association of Women Business Owners ("NAWBO") including, but not limited to NAWBO San Antonio, and all of its members, employees, volunteers, officers, and directors, and you accept sole responsibility for any illness, injury, disability or death to you or your household. Further, you promise not to sue NAWBO or any related entity including NAWBO San Antonio for any of the foregoing.

You confirm that **you and no one else in your household** are or have experienced at any time any of the following concerns within the last 14 days:

- Any new or worsening COVID-19 symptoms such as fever (99.5 degrees or higher), loss of taste, or loss of smell;
- Suffer from any significant respiratory medical condition; or
- Been exposed to any individual that has tested positive for COVID-19.

By signing below, you agree that **you have read and understand this agreement and enter into it voluntarily** in consideration for the opportunity for you to participate in NAWBO San Antonio in-person activities.

You agree to monitor all COVID-19 symptoms for you and all members of your household, and you agree to not participate in any in-person NAWBO San Antonio activities if you or any member of your household experience any of the above listed concerns.
